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We are pleased to enclose the initial programme details of the Patrons and Partners Lagos Art Tour hosted by Guest Artists Space (G.A.S.) Foundation. This year's tour will run from Tuesday, 29<sup>th</sup> of October to Sunday, 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2024.

The trip will be in the company of the artist Yinka Shonibare CBE, and the trustees and staff of Guest Artists Space Foundation and the Yinka Shonibare Foundation.

The trip is led by Belinda Holden (CEO, Y.S.F.), Moni Aisida (Executive Director, G.A.S.), Siti Osman (Philanthropy and Patrons Manager, Y.S.F.), Magda Kaggwa (Communications and Projects Manager, Y.S.F.), Adekunle Adeboye (Residency Manager, G.A.S. Foundation) and Tomiwa Adegbola (Library and Projects Coordinator, G.A.S.).

We have recommended a hotel with negotiated rates to make arrangements as convenient as possible. The nature of security and logistics of travel in Nigeria means that we are providing airport concierge, visa on arrival services, security and local transportation to/from the airport and all programmed activities.

Patrons and Partners who opt in to join only part of the Lagos Art Tour 2024 are invited to make their own arrangements to and from our designated hotel, where they can join the G.A.S. minibuses that will transport them to programmed activities.

Patrons and Partners who are only joining part of the activities on each day are invited to make their own arrangements to and from each visit, however if they are not frequent travelers to Nigeria, we advise they contact the Y.S.F. Team to discuss arrangements and options.

A detailed itinerary and information pack will be sent out to all guests a minimum of one week prior to arrival and will list all guests, staff contacts and mobile numbers. Any further information packs will be provided on arrival.

Please kindly note that meals on Tuesday arrival, Wednesday evening and Sunday are not included in the package cost of this trip, but our partner hotel has a good restaurant, and we will include a list of recommended restaurants with the detailed itinerary.





#### G.A.S. Farm House

Partners and Patrons will have the opportunity to visit both G.A.S. Foundation residency sites during the trip. We are planning to take our guests to the G.A.S. Farm House on Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> October. This residency building, designed by Nigerian architect Papa Omotayo, sits on the 54-acre Ecology Green Farm located on the outskirts of the village of Ikise in Ogun State, Nigeria. The remote location, whilst abundant in natural beauty has precluded the local community from accessing the kinds of opportunities that are available to those living in rapidly urbanised areas of Nigeria.

The challenges facing the local community were fundamental components of defining the long-term objectives of this ambitious project and include providing infrastructure for rural economic development, addressing food insecurity, and tackling economic deprivation.

Kindly note that the trip to the farm may be subject to cancellation depending on weather and road conditions. It will involve a long road trip (approx. 3 hours) on routes that can be uneven and bumpy. We appreciate that some of our guests may find this duration challenging and have broken up both legs of the route with a studio and museum visit for comfort.

Our Patrons and Partners will be invited to an intimate studio visit with our current G.A.S. Lagos residents. A tour of the award winning G.A.S. Lagos building designed by Elsie Owusu in collaboration with Nihinlola Shonibare will also be included in the visit.

As part of the Lagos Art Tour programming, we'll be hosting a networking afternoon with local artists and cultural stakeholders on Friday 1st November alongside our annual G.A.S. party on the evening of Saturday 2nd November. These exciting experiences will be complimented by museum, gallery, private collection, and studio visits that will give our guests a flavour of the city's thriving art scene.

#### **Flights**

Please notify us using this **GUEST INFORMATION FORM** as soon as you have booked your flights. This is so that we are able to co-ordinate Airport
Concierge to meet you off the plane, escort you through the airport, secure your visa on arrival, assist you through customs, and collect your luggage. They will then hand you over to our driver and security in the diplomatic carpark.

Flights to Nigeria at this time are increasing in cost daily so we would encourage you to book as soon as possible. More reasonable flights are available if you add a stop or by booking with a service like Skyscanner or equivalent.

Direct flights from London Heathrow airport can be booked with either:

Main airlines flying from elsewhere in Europe include:

#### Visa

We are currently arranging a Visa on Arrival service for all guests. This is the most convenient way to enter the country as there can be delays and issues with obtaining a visa through your residing country's Nigerian Embassy or Consulate.

Please make sure that your passport is valid for at least six months from the 29<sup>th</sup> October 2024.

We have included the visa fees in the trip costs. As a guide, these are subject to daily exchange rate changes but estimated between \$450 - \$600 for American passports and £400 - £550 for UK passports.

We have reviewed and selected the following hotel for our guests based on its reliability, cleanliness, security, and on-site restaurant. This hotel will be the pickup point for all programmed visits.







#### The Art Hotel

This boutique 49-room hotel, which opened in 2022, is conveniently located in the heart of Victoria Island's business district. It is clean and spacious with a good restaurant, pool and gym. The location is very convenient for access to G.A.S. Lagos, restaurants, and most visits.

Room types available range from a Duke Room (36 sq m) to the Emperor Suite (84 sq m). All reservations include complimentary breakfast (for one guest), free high speed WIFI, and access to the gym and pool. USD is the only foreign currency The Art Hotel currently accepts. If paying ahead, payment can only be made in USD or NGN however international cards are accepted within the hotel premises via POS.

We have negotiated a 15% discounted rate on rooms. The discounted room rates at The Art Hotel are as follows:

Please kindly note that discounted rates have not been negotiated for these hotels, therefore, the room rate is as advertised on their respective websites.

#### **Vaccinations**

Please check with your doctor or physician before you travel to ensure that you are up to date with recommended travel vaccines for Nigeria such as Cholera, Tetanus, Polio, Diphtheria, and Typhoid etc. <u>A Yellow Fever vaccination is required for entry into the country</u>, and you must travel with you Yellow Fever Vaccination Card.

Malaria tablets should form an essential part of your travel kit, please follow the instructions on starting any course in advance of your arrival and remember to bring any other regular medication.

#### **Local Conditions**

Lagos has a sub-tropical humid climate and during November the temperature typically varies from 75°F to 90°F (24°C to 32°C) and is rarely above 94°F (34.4°C). We recommend clothing that will keep you cool but there are also some air-conditioned spaces in the itinerary in particular at the more formal evening receptions.

Sunrise is approximately 6.30am and sunset 6.25pm. For the trip to the farm please consider bringing sun block, a sun hat, long trousers, and closed shoes.

#### Currency

Please do not attempt to bring more than \$10,000 of any cash currency into the country however should you chose to do so, you will have to declare this at customs. The currency exchange rates for Naira are fluctuating and we can assist in directing you to reputable currency exchanges that will give a better rate than the banks. Please let us know in advance if this will be required.

#### A note on international bank cards

Please take at least two international bank cards with you. MasterCard is the most commonly accepted network followed by Visa. American Express however, may be difficult to use in many places. Keep your bank informed about travel to Nigeria. You may also consider multi-currency travel cards like Revolut or Wise. The hotel accepts most international bank cards as will most of the restaurants we will recommend but please check the exchange rate for the transaction and pay in the local currency as it always results in a better conversion rate.

Small local shops will not accept international cards and there is a limit on the amount of cash that can be dispensed from cashpoints with a debit card. If you do need access to cash whilst in Lagos, please let us know and we will arrange for you to go and use a reputable bank with our security officer.

#### Data and Roaming

For the duration of your time in Nigeria we strongly recommend that you use either <u>Holafly</u> or <u>Airalo</u>, international e-sim providers for travel abroad. Guest information and updates will be disseminated via WhatsApp so provisions for roaming are crucial. Prior to your arrival in Lagos, kindly purchase an international phone plan, this will help ensure that you always have internet connection. If your mobile phone does not have e-sim features, please reach out to our team as soon as possible so that an alternative solution can be suggested.

#### MOWAA Institute Trip (4th-5th Nov 2024)

This year our guests have the option to join a short trip to Benin City for the opening of the Museum of West African Art Institute.

The two-day visit will include tours, discussions and social gatherings across the 15-acre site alongside a curated itinerary of visits to significant local arts and culture spaces.

Please kindly note that whilst G.A.S. and Y.S.F. staff will be in attendance this trip is independently coordinated and managed by the MOWAA events team and does not fall into our itinerary.
